Tent for two costs \$8 cheep, and sites with electric is only \$12 for two people.

A few of us, retirees will be there on Monday, October 5th for the whole week through the weekend. A few plan on coming during the week and some on the weekend. Bobby Sogolow will be the road captain. He has a motorcycle scenic rides book with NINE different loops, ranging from 70 to 140 miles. I was told that there is a small breakfast cafe across the camground and another restaurant is 4 miles away. Bring some munchies just in case! Be sure to bring warm clothes.
